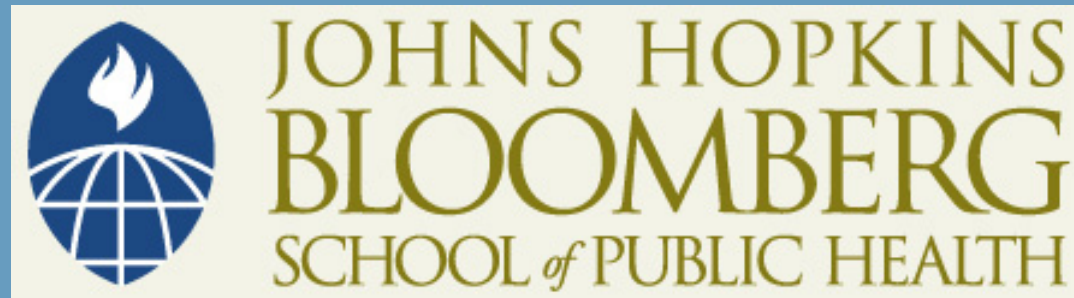

Children in the United States

Child Population in the United States, 2007

- 73.9 million (by 2020 it will be 80 million)
 - Children 0 to 5 years old: 25 million
 - Children 6 to 11 years old: 24 million
 - Children 12 to 17 years old: 25 million

Marital Status and Children

- 38% of all births are to unmarried women
- Percent of children under 18 years old living with two married parents
 - 1980: 77%
 - 2007: 68%

Children in Poverty 2007

- 17% of children lived in poverty
 - White: 10%
 - Black: 33%
 - Latino: 27%

Children in Poverty 2007

Ethnicity	Married	Single
White	4	33
Black	12	50
Latino	19	47

Children and Health Care 2005-2006

- 12% (8.7 million) without health insurance
- 6% with no regular source of health care
- 24% had no dental visit in the previous year
